1 INTRODUCTION

3 AIR QUALITY

3.1 DEPOSITIONAL DUST

All depositional dust sampling locations were in compliance with the rolling annual average limit $(4g/m^2/month)$ for the period May 2022 to April 2023. Maximum annual increase in deposited dust levels are also below the criteria limit of $2 g/m^2/month$. Depositional dust monitoring results are presented in **Table 1**.

3.2 PM₁₀ AND TSP

The 24-hour maximum PM_{10} particulate matter concentration less than 10 microns (PM_{10}) criterion of $50\mu g/m^3$ was exceeded on one scheduled run day during April 2023 (5 April 2023). The total suspended particulate (TSP) and PM_{10} annual average results were in compliance with the annual average limit for the period May 2022 to April 2023.

PM₁₀ and TSP monitoring results are presented in **Table 2**.

4 SURFACE WATER QUALITY

A discharge event is deemed to occur when water leaves the site either through the overflow channel of either Dam 3 or Dam 4, or as a result of actively pumping water. A discharge event was not observed At Dam 3 during the site visit on 5 April 2023 therefore, a sample was not required to be collected at Dam 3 (EPA Point 1). A sample was collected from Dam 3 for due diligence purposes only. A discharge event was observed at Dam 4 (EPA Point 4) on 5 April 2023. A discharge sample was collected from Dam 4. Water quality results are presented in **Table 3**.
