3 ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION LICENCE DETAILS

3.1 DEPOSITIONAL DUST

All depositional dust sampling locations were in compliance with the rolling annual average limit (4 g/m² /month) for the period July 2023 to June 2024. The maximum annual increase in deposited dust levels are also below the criteria limit of 2 g/m² /month.

Depositional dust monitoring results are presented in **Table 1**.

3.2 PM10 AND TSP

The 24-hour maximum PM₁₀ particulate matter concentration less than 10 microns (PM₁₀) criterion of 50 µg/m³ was not exceeded during June 2024. There were samples not recorded for the month of June due to a failure in the dust gauge generator. The TSP and PM₁₀ annual rolling average results were calculated with the available data for the period of July 2023 to June 2024.

The average values were less than the annual average EPL limit as presented in **Table 2**.

4 SURFACE WATER QUALITY

A discharge event is deemed to occur when water leaves the site either through the overflow channel of the Main Dam or as a result of actively pumping water. No discharge occurred from the Main Dam Discharge Point 2 (LD002) during June 2024. A monthly sample was collected from the Main Dam for due diligence purposes only.

Water quality results are presented in **Table 3**.
