	RT Workshop Update
	- TMH and TH reported that a temporary workshop has been installed.
	- Plans for a permanent facility are in progress.
	CVM Weed Spraying (Spring/Summer)
	- Focus weeds: St John's Wart and Blackberries.
	- TMH confirmed that a contractor has been procured, and spraying is
	scheduled to commence between October and December.
	Noisy Pump (Dam 3)
	<ul> <li>The noisy pump at D3 was noted for follow-up and investigation.</li> <li>Discussion held regarding the pump at CVM Dam 4 and whether it could revert to an electric motor.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Not possible, as the high-voltage power supply has been shut off due to lack of use.</li> </ul>
	- TJH and TMH informed BF that the team is working on sourcing a quieter
	motor as an alternative solution.
	CVM Hotspots
	- Action: To speak with Graham Goodwin regarding identified CVM hotspots.
	Walking Path at Cullen Bullen (Near Skips)
	- New item raised concerning the walking path near the skips at Cullen
	Bullen Proposal for a walkway down the skip line, creating a safer path around the
	area.
	- RB has obtained quotes and provided them to TMH.
	- TJH expressed willingness to meet with RB on-site and will look into
	donating funds to support the project
OPERATIONAL UPDATE	
TENEMENT AND OPTIONS REVIEW	
COMPLAINTS	- BF identified logged complaints for June 2025 are inaccurate on CC reporting. Complaints were received on 6th, 12th, 16th, 18th, 20th, and 21st June.
	- CC will look into errors in reporting.
CORRESPONDENCE	<ul> <li>A request was made for Castlereagh Coal (CC) to provide more frequent updates and additional information regarding INV and CVM activities between meetings.</li> </ul>
	- If responses are not satisfactory, escalate the matter to TJH.
ENVIRONMENTAL	Water Transfer Between Dams
PERFORMANCE	<ul> <li>Concern raised regarding potential overflow when transferring water from one dam to another.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>TMH and TJH explained the plans to manage water levels and maintain appropriate freeboard.</li> </ul>
	Water Runoff on Private Property
	- MB raised a concern regarding water running across his property, creating a "swamp" area.

	<ul> <li>TJH and TMH outlined the rehab and testing plans and will investigate the material being tipped off.</li> </ul>	
	- Feedback will be provided to CCC members once reviewed.	
	Rehabilitation Design	
	- Query on how the rehabilitation area will appear once complete.	
	- TMH provided details on the rehabilitation plans and projected outcomes.

	- Current consent lapsing on 31st December 2025.	
	<ul> <li>MOD6 is under determination by the Department of Planning, Housing &amp; Infrastructure, with a decision expected mid-late October 2025.</li> </ul>	
	- Approximately 2.2 million tonnes of coal reserves remain to be extracted.	
	Cullen Valley Mine (CVM)	
	- Current consent lapsing on 19th August 2030.	
	- Approximately 500,000 tonnes of coal reserves remain to be extracted.	
GENERAL BUSINESS	CVM/Haul Road Gate	
	- On 07/08, the gate at CVM/Haul Road was found open toward the road.	
	<ul> <li>TJH stated that pre-existing latches are in place, and he will communicate with the road truck manager regarding proper use.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Coal located at the turn from the Highway onto Boulder Road requires clean-up.</li> </ul>
